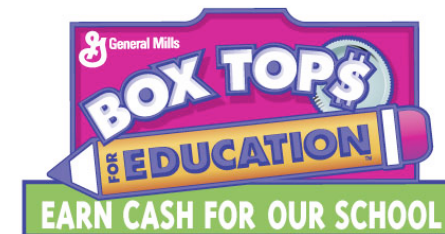




# U.S. Flag Box Tops Contest

Dear Parents, Grandparents, Aunts, Uncles, Neighbors and Friends:

Channahon School District 17 is collecting Box Tops for Education coupons as an important fundraiser. The district receives \$0.10 for each Box Top. These Box Tops can be found on most General Mills products, including Big "G" cereals, Pillsbury®, Betty Crocker®, Yoplait®, Progresso®, Old El Paso®, Pop Secret® and many others. They are pink with a yellow pencil and look like the logo above.

In order to make this effort fun and educational for the kids, we are having another exciting contest. The contest will run from March 1, 2010 through February 1, 2011. At the end of the contest will be a raffle drawing. Prizes are yet to be determined. On the back on this letter you will find the entry form - please ask your relatives, neighbors and friends to help as well. PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT CAMPBELL'S SOUP LABELS IN THIS CONTEST.

## The rules are simple:

1. Tape or paste (do not staple) one Box Tops for Education coupon on each square. Please do not submit EXPIRED Box Tops.
2. When you have covered each flag (25 Box Tops), put your child's name and grade for year 2009-10 on the form.
3. Send to school with your child. **All entries must be received no later than February 1, 2011.**
4. The drawing for prizes will be held at the **February 10, 2011** PTO Meeting.
5. Enter as many times as you wish. Involve your kids and get your friends and relatives to help!
6. If you have a bonus strip from a grocery store, simply tape it over as many entry forms that can be applied and send it in. For example: If you have a 70 bonus strip, use 3 entry forms along with 5 extra coupons to total 75 coupons. Don't forget to put your child's name and grade on each form.
7. If you have several kids in school, you may put all of their names on the form for a "family entry."
8. **Additional forms are available in the school office, on the district website or you can make copies on your own.**
