On Saturday the team dropped their first game of the day to eventual tournament champs Manteno 30 to 26. Manteno iced the game with seconds remaining by making two free throws. Nate McBroom had 11 points and Kam Chigi had 10.

In the final game of the day the boys defeated host Oak Prairie in another hard fought game. The team squandered a 6 point lead earlier in the fourth quarter and fell behind with less than a minute to play. Joey Lucas stole the ball with 48 seconds remaining and the team advanced the ball down the court on a fastbreak. Luan Osamani tipped in the missed layup giving Channahon a one point lead. On Oak Prairie's next possession they turned over the ball and had to foul. Joey Lucas sank two free throws Channahon a 3 point lead. Oak Prairie's final shot fell short giving the team a victory

and a second place finish in the tournament. Seven players contributed to Channahon's scoring Joey Lucas, Caleb Kies, Luan Osmani, Joey Partridge, Cade Terrill, Nate McBroom, and Andrew Earl.
