## Parents MUST bring the following to receive supplies and services:

- **Identification for all household members:**  
 Adults: state ID or driver's license; passport; Mexican consulate ID  
 Children: birth certificate, social security card, medical card, Mexican consulate ID
- **Proof of Income:**  
 Printouts from: public aid, social security, unemployment, food stamp printout, link card, check stub, or medical card.
- **Verification of Address:**  
 Current utility bill and/or government mail showing Will County address

**Any child attending fair MUST be accompanied by an adult. If parent/guardian is unable to attend the fair, their adult representative must bring all documentation noted above for the absent parent and children.**
